Course Structure:

To be awarded this qualification the learner must attain a successful assessment in a total of 11 units grouped into 3 modules.

Module 1 consists of the core generalist competencies of:

- PSPETHC501B – Promote the values and ethos of public service
- PSPGOV504B – Undertake research and analysis
- PSPGOV505A – Promote diversity
- PSPGOV512A – Use complex workplace communication strategies
- PSPLEGN501B – Promote compliance with legislation in the public sector

Module 2 consists of specialist competencies:

- PSPSEC501A – Assess security risks
- PSPSEC502A – Develop security risk management plans
- PSPSEC503A – Implement and monitor security risk management plans
- PSPSEC504A – Coordinate protective security

Module 3 consists of electives chosen from:

2 electives from:

- Anywhere in this training package at the same or a higher level and/or from any other endorses set of standards packaged at the same or higher level provided they do not duplicate any content covered in an of the PSP units.
- Alternatively, one elective can be chosen from a unit of competency at the Certificate III level.
